<b>Activity Descriptor</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Future Planners initiative, led by the Royal Town Planning Institute (RTPI), is an initiative designed to inspire the future workforce to consider a career in town planning.</li> <li>This resource comprises a presentation and film to raise awareness and inspire the future generation to consider a career in town planning.</li> </ul>
<b>Activity Aims</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To raise awareness of careers in town planning.</li> </ul>
<b>Activity Length</b> <i>All timings given are approximate and for the basic activity described here. Additional time should be allowed for extensions</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>40–60 minutes.</li> </ul>
<b>Preparation Required</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>This presentation can either be delivered by a town planning professional, teacher or another adult who has prior knowledge of careers, town planning, the built environment or geography. It could also be suitable to be delivered as part of the curriculum in Business Studies, History, Politics or Citizenship.
