

#8 CLOSING YOUR SESSION

A reference card to support your teaching approach...

1

WHAT: Reflect on the session content

- Use the learners to help recall/reflect on the session, here's an example phrase...
- "What were your key takeaways from today's session? Can anyone share something they learned?"

2

HOW: Ask the learner what they liked/found challenging

- Take time to explore how the group got on in the session, asking things like...
- "What did you find most challenging about this task? What did you enjoy the most?"

3

WHY: Ask or offer the reasons why this is important

- Relate the lesson back to real world situations asking, the learners...
- "Why do you think this skill is important in the real world? Think about how it applies to day-to-day work."

4

WHAT NEXT: Share how this leads into the next thing

- Share what learners can expect in the upcoming sessions, stating for example...
- "Next time, we'll build on what we covered today and take it to the next level."

A strong closing reinforces the sessions learning and sets learners up for future success. Reflect on what's been covered, highlight its importance, and give a clear sense of where they'll go next. A thoughtful conclusion keeps the momentum going.
