

#4 SHOW AND TELL

A reference card to support your teaching approach...

1

POSITIONING: Ensure everyone can see/hear you

- Make sure you stand where everyone can see and hear you.
- Ask learners to move so you are visible to them to maximise the use of demonstrations.

2

DIFFERENT ANGLES: Learners to observe from different

- Encourage learners to move around to see the demonstration from different angles.
- This helps them better appreciate the technique. And ensures its seen more than once.

3

LEARNER DEMONSTRATION: Invite a 'confident' learner to have a go

- Encourage learners to show their work in action - try this phrasing...
- "Let's have one of you try it out. I'll guide you with feedback as you go".

4

INDEPENDENT WORK: Let learners have a go themselves

- Encourage learners to have ago themselves - try this phrasing...
- "Now, it's your turn. Work independently, and I'll come around to support you as needed."

A well-executed demonstration not only shows learners how to complete a task, but also builds their confidence to try it themselves. Remember to engage your learners by offering them the chance to participate and observe from different perspectives.
