

#5 NOTICING

A reference card to support your teaching approach...

1

BIG PICTURE: Stand back, watch the whole thing

- First, stand back and observe the overall process.
- Consider what's working well and is there anything that stands out?

2

SMALL DETAILS: Get closer to details that are important

- Next, take a closer look at the finer points, the details that will make the biggest difference.
- Identifying (and making) small adjustments can make a big difference in the final outcome.

3

WATCH MORE THAN ONCE: Success and failure can be a one off

- Remember, success or failure on the first attempt can be a one off.
- Make sure you watch again to get an accurate picture.

4

DIFFERENT ANGLES: Move around observe from different positions

- Move around work stations to observe learners in action from various positions.
- A new angle might reveal something important that would otherwise be missed.

Effective observation allows you to guide your learners with targeted feedback that addresses both strengths and areas for improvement. Remember, watching from different angles and checking work more than once.
